

**NOTES ON SENIOR OLYMPICS DANCESPORT
COMPETITION IN BATON ROUGE, AUGUST 2006**

For the first time, the Greater Baton Rouge District of the Louisiana Senior Olympic Games held a dancesport competition on August 5, 2006. The event was planned and staged with the assistance of members of Saturday Night Ballroom (SNB), and it was held on the afternoon before the August SNB dance party and at the same venue, the American Legion Post 38.

The event was restricted to amateur couples aged 50 and above. The rules included three age groups and three skill levels. The dance events included foxtrot, waltz, tango, rumba, cha cha, and swing.

The event attracted 44 dancers. The judges were professional instructors Tammy Clark, Bill Anderson, Brad Petrie, and James Heath. The emcee was Marla Corpora. Peggy and Charles Clement served as registrars and scrutineers.

Among the couples winning the top awards were Jack and Suzanne Jaubert of Baton Rouge, and Jim and Ann Durocher-Steven, of Houma.
